Doctor at health centre. See further information below.

Requirements for education

Specialist exam in family medicine from within EU.

Required experience

At least three years of experience as a family medicine specialist in primary care with good recommendations, to be able to supervise other training doctors after about 2 years of employment in Sweden. Extract from criminal records - has to be clear.

Personal qualities required for the position

Flexible, driven, socially outgoing, interested in supervision.

We are looking for two doctors, one to work at the branch in Anderstorp and one in Gislaved.

On-call duty

Approximately every 4 weeks we have a duty at the emergency centre in Värnamo. Evening hours from 17 to 22 and Saturdays and Sundays from 10 to 22 00.

Other requirements

The first three months an introduction in Swedish healthcare will take place at Nässjö

Education Center 3 days / week –or there will be good supervision at the health centre. Every Friday there is a common education in Jönköping that contains introduction to the Swedish healthcare system and education in the Swedish language.

Salary for staff with Swedish legitimation

45.000 SEK during the first 6 months introductory period, after that approximately 54 000

SEK, which will raise to be a normal GP-salary after two years, which is at least 60 000 SEK.

Description of the goal of activity

One that is characterized by care, completeness and health for all! Offer an easy-to-use care with continuity and quality. Our aim is the patient's health and the patient must feel he is in safe hands. After a visit by our place, the patient must leave us with the feeling of being seen, listened to and professionally treated with a clear awareness of what the next step is in the care process.

Description of the health centre

Gislaved Health Centre is one of the 33 health centres that are part of the Bra Liv Group.

Gislaved Health Centre is responsible for approximately 11,000, Anderstorp appr. 4.500

patients and we also have a branch in Hestra. We have a relatively aged population and a large proportion comes from different cultures and has different ethnic backgrounds. At Gislaved / Anderstorp Health Centre there are about 60 employees, of whom 7 are doctors. The following occupational categories are employed at the health centre: doctors, nurses, subnurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapist, psychologist, curator, leg therapist, health administrators. We work in team with different occupational categories. The health centre is located in Gislaved municipality. There are good opportunities for outdoor activities and sports close to nature. There is good service for families with a good range of preschools and schools.

Gislaved municipality have a great interest in music with a good music school.

Further information

During the first three months there will take place an introduction in Swedish healthcare at Nässjö Education Centre 3 days / week. One further day you will be at your healthcare centre and one day you will have an introduction to the Swedish healthcare system at seminars. After you have spent a year at Gislaved / Anderstorp Health Centre, there will follow an approximately 5 months of side-service at various clinics at Eksjö Hospital to create network with colleagues and learn what is being done in primary care / end in-patient care. Generally, the doctor is expected to have full competence to be able to take full

responsibility at the Health Centre after about 2 years spent in Sweden. Has then to able to handle own training doctors.

Services offered by the employer and Partner:

- During the personal visit which is part of the interview process, the cost of travel and accommodation is financed by Partner
- 6 months long, free Swedish course, financial support during the course (the amount is topic of negotiation)
- Free language education for family members – to B2 level for spouses and school-age children, to C1 level for spouses who have jobs with licence requirement
- Informal help during the application for Swedish license to practice, supervision of the process
- 2 days long free Swedish legal and social training
- Integration assistance (assistance in registering at tax authority, opening bank account, etc.)
- Assistance in finding school/kindergarten for the children
- Assistance in the organization of moving and in apartment-seeking Family medicine - Jönköping

- Professional English CV in which your experience (number of completed examinations/surgeries, with differentiation between pre-and post-specialization experience) are detailed
- cover letter
- scanned version of license to practice in home country with English translation (no official needed)
- scanned version of medical and specialist certificates with English translation (no official needed)
- two English-speaking reference persons who are reachable on phone
- proof of language knowledge (if you have such)
