About the department:

A dynamic department with roughly 80 employees who can be divided between 10-12 different professions. Assignments of the Staff Specialist:

- The Staff Specialist will hold the medical responsibility of treatments of general psychiatry at the outpatient clinic.
 - To contribute to constructive relations of cooperation among and the between the staff, patients, parents/relatives and professional partners of cooperation.
 - To coordinate continuity of care in dialogue with the patient, parents/relatives and contact persons of the patient among external partners of cooperation.
 - To ensure coherence between capacity and assignments in cooperation with the functional management.
 - To ensure that clinical guidelines are applied
 - To undertake methodological choices with support of the Consultant of child- and adolescence psychiatry.
 - To resolve specific clinical assignments
 - To ensure attention on somatic and medical states
 - To institute health promotive activities
 - To ensure that aspects of resources and recovery are included in courses of treatment
 - To contribute to systematically development of competences of colleagues, including supervision
 - To engage in own training and education
 - To ensure that objective of quality are observed
 - To ensure an effective and economically viable of resources of the area of treatment
- Geographically, the Center of Child and Adolescence Psychiatry South Jutland is placed in three locations: Aabenraa, Esbjerg and Vejle.

The department is divided between an outpatient clinic, a day clinic and a 24-hour section.

The outpatient clinic is divided into teams: a neuropsychiatric team, an affective team, an eating disorder team and a psychoses team. The treatments are aimed at children and adolescents between 3-19 years of age. Furthermore, the department has an acute duty. The teams are interdisciplinary and are managed professionally by a consultant. In addition to the outpatient clinic there is a day clinic, which is primarily for the 6-16 year-olds and a 24-hour section for adolescents (13-19 year-olds). The 24-hour section has 7 beds for adolescents who are more than 13-years-old.

The day clinic has 6-8 beds primarily for the 6- 16-year-olds. A school is affiliated to both our day clinic and our 24-hour section. It will be possible for the right candidate, to influence the position in order to accommodate personal interests and competencies.

The consultant shall refer to the heads of department and must work closely together with the outpatient clinic's functional manager and the other doctors at the department.

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Language learning

- We offer you a free, intensive Danish language course from zero to B2 level in English.
- the training is in Budapest and focuses on communication skills. The first 5 months are daily learning in a class structure and the last 2 weeks cover medical vocabulary via Skype teaching.
- We also offer teaching for the spouses and for elder children.
- You can participate in Extra Danish classes after arrival to Denmark.
