technology stack including Azure, offering our clients a SaaS solution. The DevOps / System team Engineer is responsible for:

- Create and maintain infrastructure, including continuous integration, automated builds, and automated build verification testing.
- Create, maintain and improve platforms and environments for solution demonstration, QA, user testing, etc.
- Support Continuous Delivery through automating Release Management
- Facilitate the technical aspects of collaboration with third parties, such as data or service providers, hosting facilities, etc.
- Participate in PI Planning and the Pre- and Post-PI Planning meetings at the value stream level, and in backlog refinement to define integration and test Capabilities and Features
- Determine and help maintain decisions and policies for appropriate branching models.
- Run solution-level integration scripts or integrate manually where automation is impossible
- Assist component teams in defining inter-component interfaces.
- Attend other teams' stand-ups in support of daily activities.
- Create and perform new automated test scenarios, following Acceptance Test Driven Development guidelines, and extend test scenarios to larger data sets.
- Prioritize time-consuming tests, refactor, and run reduced test suites where applicable. • Test the solution performance against non-functional requirements and assist System and Solution Engineering in identifying system shortfalls and bottlenecks.
