Different health centres, SWEDEN



Job description

You are responsible for a population base of about 10 - 19,000 listed patients aged 0-115 years with varying diagnoses. As a General Specialist / Family Doctor, you are the first level of care and have to be able to assess what conditions you and your team have to treat and what have to be passed on to specialist care.

Your tasks include:

- Patients who come to the health centre, retirement homes, supervision of students / training doctors / other staff, work life efforts, life-oriented prevention work, etc. –
- Collaboration with other professional categories at the health centre in diagnostic-oriented teams and with other authorities on issues such as home care, sick leave, unemployment, social services, etc. are common.

The working time is for full-time 40 hours / week and the most common working time is from 8 am-5 pm (may, however, change in the future).

Requirements for education

Specialist exam in General Medicine / Family Medicine from within the EU.

Required experience

At least one year of experience as a General Medicine / Family Medicine specialist in Primary Care with good recommendations, to be able to supervise other training doctors after about 2 years of employment in Sweden. Extract from criminal records - has to be clear.

Personal qualities required for the position

Emphatic, self-confident, flexible, driven, socially outgoing, interested in supervision.

On-call duty

Some on-call duties corresponding to about 1 occasion in 4 weeks is included in the service.

Other requirements

During the first four months an introduction in Swedish healthcare will take place at Nässjö Education Centre 3 days / week.

Salary for staff with Swedish legitimation

The normal salary for GP-s (besides full responsibility for independent work) is **60 000 – 80.000 SEK (6-8.000 Euros)**. The 60.000 SEK is for newly graduated specialists. The more years Family medicine – Jönköping of experience as a GP, the more salary could be expected. (I.e. if one has already worked even 2-3 years as a GP in the homeland before leaving to Sweden, then the expected salary after the introductory period in Sweden will be higher than 60.000 – 80.000 SEK.)

However, during the first 6 months introductory period the salary will be 45.000 SEK, and after that approximately 54 000 SEK + zone-allowance, which will constantly raise to be a normal GP-salary. It is around after two years.

Description of the goal of activity

One that is characterized by care, completeness and health for all! Offer an easy-to-use care with continuity and quality. Our aim is the patient's health and the patient must feel he is in safe hands. After a visit to our place, the patient must leave us with the feeling of being seen, listened to and professionally treated with a clear awareness of what the next step is in the care process.

Description of the health centre

There are 33 health centres within Jönköping county that are part of the Group. We have health care centres both in small and large cities. We have a mixed population and a large proportion comes from different cultures and has different ethnic backgrounds. At each health centres there are about 60 employees depending of the catchment area. The following occupational categories are employed at the health centre: doctors, nurses, subnurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapist, psychologist, curator, leg therapist, health administrators. We work in teams with different occupational categories. The health centres are

located where we can offer good opportunities for outdoor activities and sports close to nature, city life, shopping etc. There is good service for families with a good range of preschools and schools. The proximity to Jönköping provides the opportunity to enjoy cultural life, and there are also colleges with a wide range of diverse courses.

Further information

During the first four months an introduction in Swedish healthcare at Nässjö Education Centre will take place 3 days / week. One further day you will be at your healthcare centre and one day you will have an introduction to the Swedish healthcare system at seminars. After you have spent a year at your health centre, an approximately 5 months of side-service will follow at different clinics at the hospital in your vicinity to create network with colleagues and learn what is being done in primary care / end in-patient care. Generally, the doctor is expected to have full competence to be able to take full responsibility at the Health Centre after about 2 years spent in Sweden. Has then to be able to handle own training doctors.

Services offered by the Employer and Partners

- During the personal visit which is part of the interview process, the cost of travel and accommodation is financed by the Partner.
- 6 months long, free Swedish course, financial support during the course (the amount is topic of negotiation)
- Possibility of free language education for family members – depends on individual agreement
- Informal help during the application for Swedish license to practice, supervision of the process
- 2 days long free Swedish legal and social training
- Integration assistance (assistance in registering at tax authority, opening bank account, etc.)
- Assistance in the organization of moving and in apartment-seeking

Documents required for application:

- Professional English CV in which your experience (number of completed examinations/surgeries, with differentiation between pre-and post-specialization experience) are detailed
- scanned version of license to practice in home country with English translation (no official needed)
- scanned version of medical and specialist certificates with English translation (no official needed)
- two English-speaking reference persons who are reachable on phone
